

The July meeting of the JVHS Alumni Association was held Thursday, July 19, 2012 at the school library. In the absence of Al Doucette, chairperson, the meeting was called to order by secretary, Lawanda Myers.



Also we will check and see if Mrs. McCoy would like to provide sweets for donations. It was agreed that we need more publicity- TV, radio, posters.

We tabled the election of the chairperson until the August meeting.
