Coach Tammie Barnes - Health & Fitness request - any requests need to go thru the Principal before it comes to the Alumni Assn.

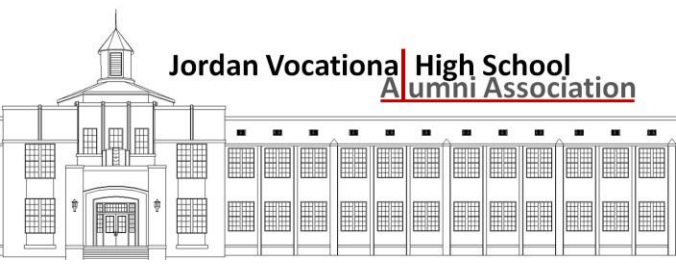
Athletic Hall of Fame - Sharon has tickets.
