90's Decade Reunion to be held but no one has contacted us.

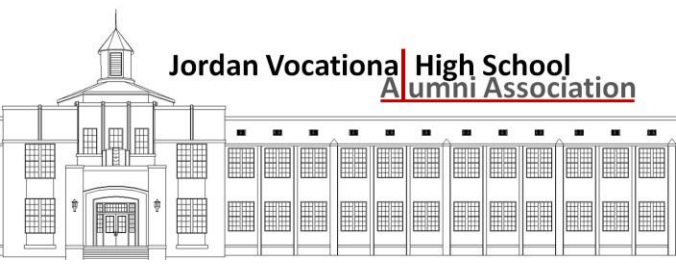
