Sharon read a thank you letter from Dorothy Hyatt for the donation in her honor

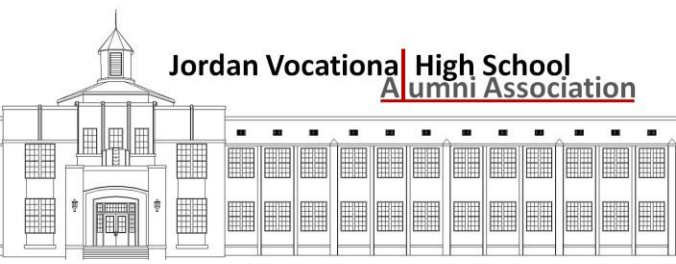
